

Kendrick Trails Map and Directions

Kendrick Petty has created and maintained a set of informal trails in Jackson State Forest. The entrance to the trails is opposite the CDF Fire Station at about 4 miles up Little Lake Road for Highway 1. **These trails are suitable for hiking only, not bicycle or horse travel.**

Park directly opposite the station at the small pullout. Walk south on the trail through pygmy/transition for quite a distance, perhaps $\frac{1}{4}$ mile or more. You will pass a relatively new, large house and clearing on the left. Watch carefully on your left for a concrete survey post (it is small, only about 18-24" high). This is shown on the map, but the writing is unclear. Turn left at the marker onto the small trail. From that point on, use the map to navigate through the trails.

There were originally markers at all of the trail intersections, but some of these may be missing; so watch carefully, especially in the eastern section.

The trail near the main north-south watercourse is quite steep in places; so one needs to have good footing and clambering ability to negotiate this trail.

Please clear the trail of branches that may have fallen and that you can move easily.
